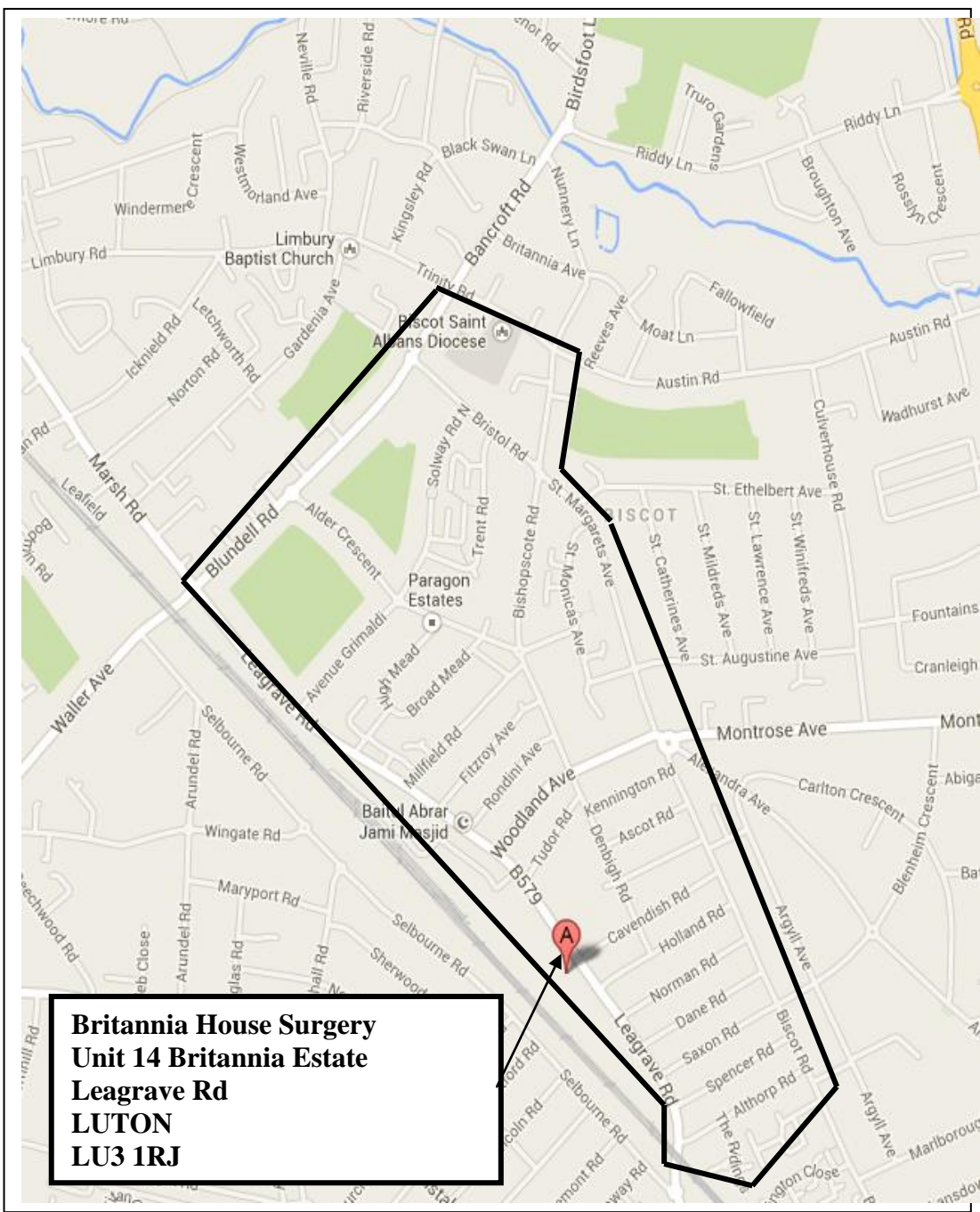

Tell us if you want someone to accompany you during an examination or discuss any matter. Remember the results of tests can only be given to the patient.

■ All patients will have a Named GP, this does not affect your care in anyway and as always you can see the Doctor of your choice, subject to availability. All aged over 75 will have an accountable GP. If your condition is **non-urgent**, you may have to wait longer if you want to see a particular GP. If you don't need an appointment within a week You also have the option to book up to 6 weeks in advance if this is more convenient for you. Nurses based in our practice treat patients for a wide range of common conditions.

We do not accept prescriptions' over the phone. You can either drop off your repeat prescription at reception or order via our website, once registered for online services. drmirzaandpartners.co.uk

Access to Data:

The Data Protection Act 1998(section 7) specifies the right of access to Data Subject. The practice is registered under the Data Protection Act 1998. ■ You can book to have a **telephone consultation** with a doctor. He or she will ring you (or you ring back) at an agreed time on the telephone number you have given.

How you can help us:

- Be on time for your appointment
 - Tell us if you need to cancel
- Call for a home visit or urgent appointment before 10am
- Ring for test results after 1pm
